LUTHULI MUSEUM ANNUAL SPELLING BEE COMPETITION

More than 18 schools have been invited to participate in this year's Luthuli Museum Spelling BEE competition that takes place on Thursday April 21.

The annual competition started last year with six schools in the ILembe district municipal area and was received with such enthusiasm that the project has now been added as a permanent fixture to the Luthuli Museum education department's calendar of events.

The aim of the competition for grade 7 learners is to improve their spelling competency and to build relationships between schools and the Luthuli Museum.

Each school fields three candidates who are required to pronounce out loud the word to be spelt and then to spell it out correctly four times over. Learners then go through a process of elimination until an ultimate winner is announced.

Each participant will get a certificate of participation and the winning school will walk away with a floating trophy.

The event has been designed to mark World Book Day on April 21.
